

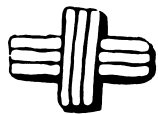

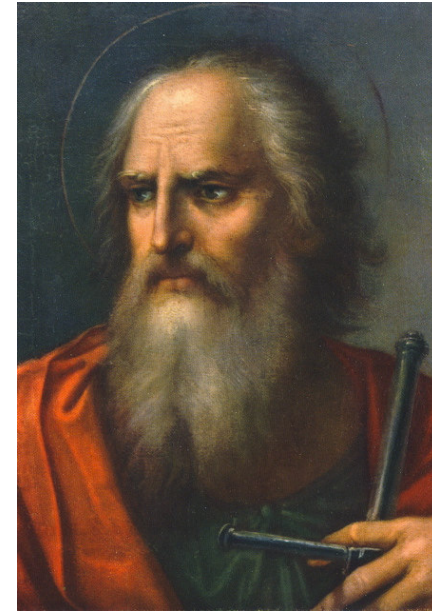

Paul continually faced criticism, opposition and danger. What can we learn from his experiences?

### **Tuesday, February 3, 2009 - *Paul and Christian Freedom***

Paul came to a new understanding of *freedom* as he encountered problems in the early faith communities. How do we understand “Christian freedom”?

### **Tuesday, March 10, 2009 - *Paul and Forgiveness***

Paul struggled deeply with issues of forgiveness, particularly of those who attacked his reputation and integrity. What can we learn from his struggles?

### **Tuesday, April 7, 2009 - *Paul the Mystic***

Paul grew into a deep personal relationship with the Risen Christ. How can we grow in our relationship with the Lord during this Holy Week and beyond?

### **Tuesday, May 5, 2009 - *Paul’s Masterpiece***

Paul’s Letter to the Romans is considered his greatest theological and literary work. What is the “masterpiece” that God has worked through our lives?

### **Tuesday, June 9, 2009 - *Paul’s Senior Years***

Paul spent much of his later life in prison, experiencing abandonment and loneliness. How can his life inspire us in our later years?
