

Home Religion Program offered in Diocese of Saskatoon

A Home Religion Program is offered by the Roman Catholic Diocese of Saskatoon for families in the rural and urban areas where parishes or schools do not offer catechetical programs.

The correspondence program consists of Grades 1 to 8 courses and follows the content and thematic topics of the Canadian catechetical program Born of the Spirit.

The correspondence program presents an opportunity for the children and family to be connected with a catechist who will assist by correcting completed lessons, as well as acting as a faith mentor to families and children. The children have the blessing of being mentored by parents and a catechist.
